A New Product

I have used the following product for quilt labels. These sheets are also recommended for photo transfers. The fabric is soft when sewn to quilts...not the stiff kind like some fabric sheets. It is called **Miracle Fabric Sheets** by a company called C. Jenkins Necktie & Chemical Company. Their web site is cjenkinscompany.com. You get 10 sheets per packet for \$15.49 which is half the price of other sheets.
