



# Sawtooth Star – January Drawing

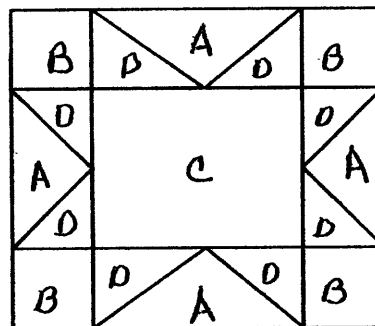
PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

These instructions are for one 12” finished block (12 ½” unfinished)

<b>Background:</b>	white or white on white
<b>Star Points:</b>	red, medium size print
<b>Star Center:</b>	red/blue/gold patriotic print (stars, stripes, flags, etc.

Background	A: cut 1	7 ¼” square	cut diagonally twice	
Background	B: cut 4	3 ½” squares		
Star Center	C: cut 1	6 ½” square		
Star Points	D: cut 4	3 7/8” square	cut diagonally once	

Using a scant ¼” seam allowance,  
assemble as follows:



**TIP: Proper pressing will give you the best results.**

Press with a light touch. Use either steam or dry heat (whichever works best for you). Choose a pressing plan before starting and try to stay consistent. (some prefer to always press to the dark fabric, some to reduce bulk)

“Set” seams by pressing flat and then pressing to either side.

Many books and magazines provide more detailed pressing instructions.

This is the fourth block in a twelve block sampler series. Make blocks in the colors indicated for the block of the month drawing, and make another block in the colors of your choice. At the end of the year you will have 12 blocks for a “Star Studded Sampler” of your own.
