

Maple Star – April Drawing

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

These instructions are for one 12" finished block (12 1/2" unfinished)

Background: white or white on white

Star Points and Star Corners: medium to dark red, medium size print

Star Sides: light blue, medium to small size print

Star Center: red/blue/gold patriotic print (stars, stripes, flags, etc.)

This is the seventh block in a twelve block sampler series. Make blocks in the colors indicated for the block of the month drawing, and make another block in the colors of your choice. At the end of the year you will have 12 blocks for a "Star Studded Sampler" of your own.

Background A: cut 1 5 1/4" square cut diagonally twice



Background B: cut 4 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

C: cut 4 2 1/2" squares

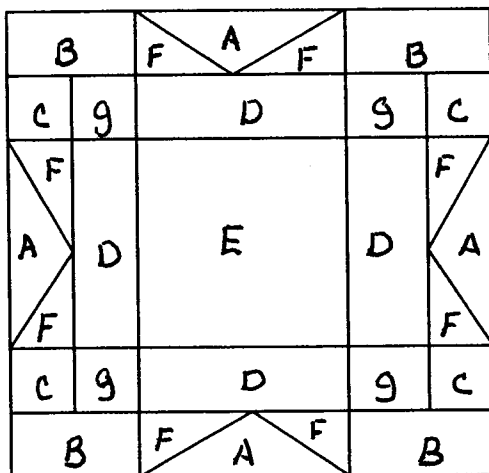
Star Sides D: cut 4 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

Star Center E: cut 1 4 1/2" square

Star Points F: cut 4 2 7/8" squares cut diagonally once



Star Corners G: cut 4 2 1/2" squares



Refer to the diagram for assembly:

1. Sew 2 Fs to each A = press to the Fs
2. Sew a D to each F/A unit = press to the Ds
3. Sew a C to each G = press to the C
4. Sew a B to each C/G unit = press to the B
5. Sew a F/A+D unit to 2 sides of the E = press to the E
6. Sew a C/G+B to each end of the remaining F/A+D units = press to the C/G+B
7. Sew the three sections together = press away from center section
