

## Row 7: Maple Leaf - April Drawing

Please read all instructions before beginning. This block will be 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished (9" x 9" finished).

This is the seventh block in a series. Make blocks in the colors indicated for the block of the month drawing at the April meeting, and make a total of five blocks in the colors of your choice for your row quilt.

**Background:** cream or cream on cream

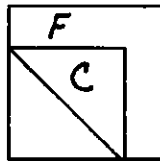
**Leaf:** print that has green, gold, rust or other fall leaf colors

**Stem:** one shade darker than the leaf fabric

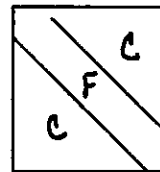
### Cutting for one block:

Background	A	cut 1	3 1/2" square
	B	cut 2	3 7/8" squares (cut each square once diagonally)
	C	cut 2	3 1/8" squares
Leaf	D	cut 3	3 1/2" squares
	E	cut 2	3 7/8" squares (cut each square once diagonally)
Stem	F	cut 1	3 1/2"

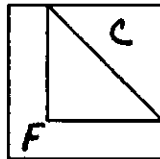
Right sides together:  
Sew one C to F  
Press to corner and  
Trim



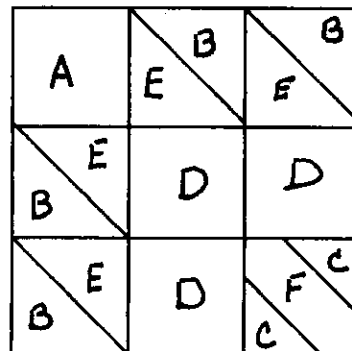
Finished stem



Repeat in the opposing  
corner



Refer to the diagram for assembly:



When you join your five blocks together, you may need to add a small spacer strip to one end to make your row the actual length of your previous rows. Note that you can turn all your leaves in one direction or alternate them to add more interest.
