

Row 8 Big & Little Trees - May Drawing

Please read all instructions before beginning. These instructions are for one 10" finished block (10 ½" unfinished)

This is the eighth block in a series. Make blocks in the colors indicated for the block of the month drawing at the May meeting, and make a total of seven blocks in the colors of your choice for your row quilt.

Background: pale blue

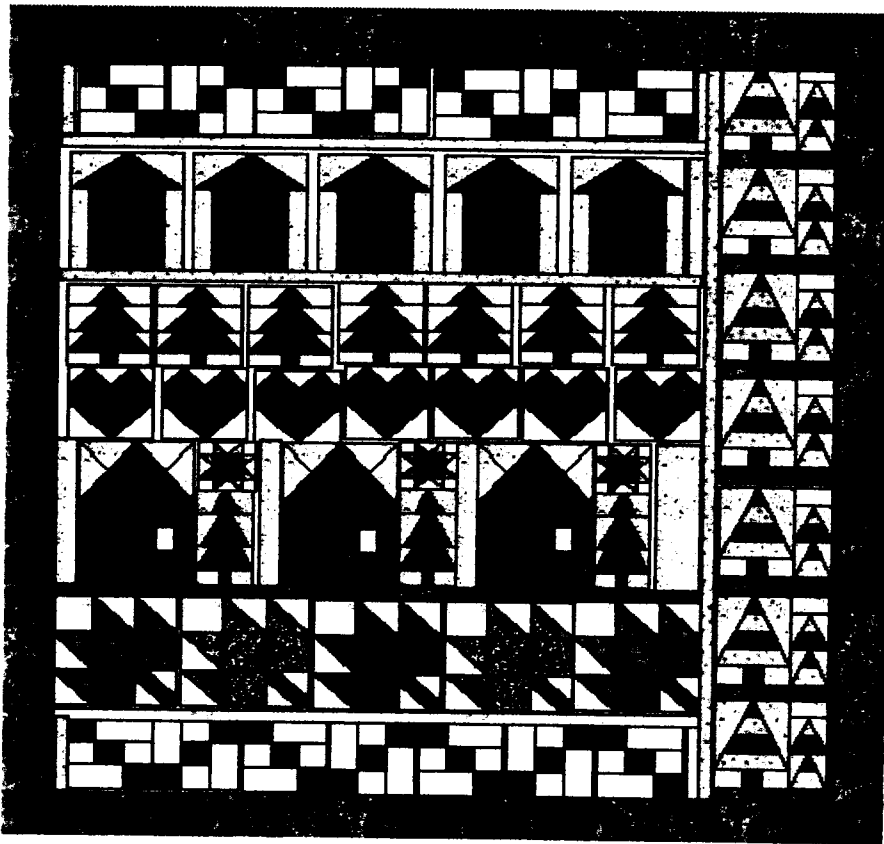
Trees: assorted greens that are pleasing together

Tree trunk: brown

Grass: green

I've not tried to give complete instructions on how to do foundation piecing. If you have not used this technique, ask your friends for help. If there is enough need, perhaps a class can be arranged - or this would make a good mini group activity.

This month we are doing something different. Attached are two pages - one has unit A and the other has unit B. These copies are to be duplicated to be used as foundations for a paper pieced block. After piecing the two units, join them together and end with a green strip (grass) to make the unfinished block 10 ½" square.



This shows the completed row quilt. This new block is sewn into a vertical row and joined to the side of the other rows we have done this year. I know that everyone will have other ideas on how to construct your own original row quilt and I look forward to seeing them at "show and tell." I hope that you have enjoyed this year's series as much as I have. Happy quilting - Carole

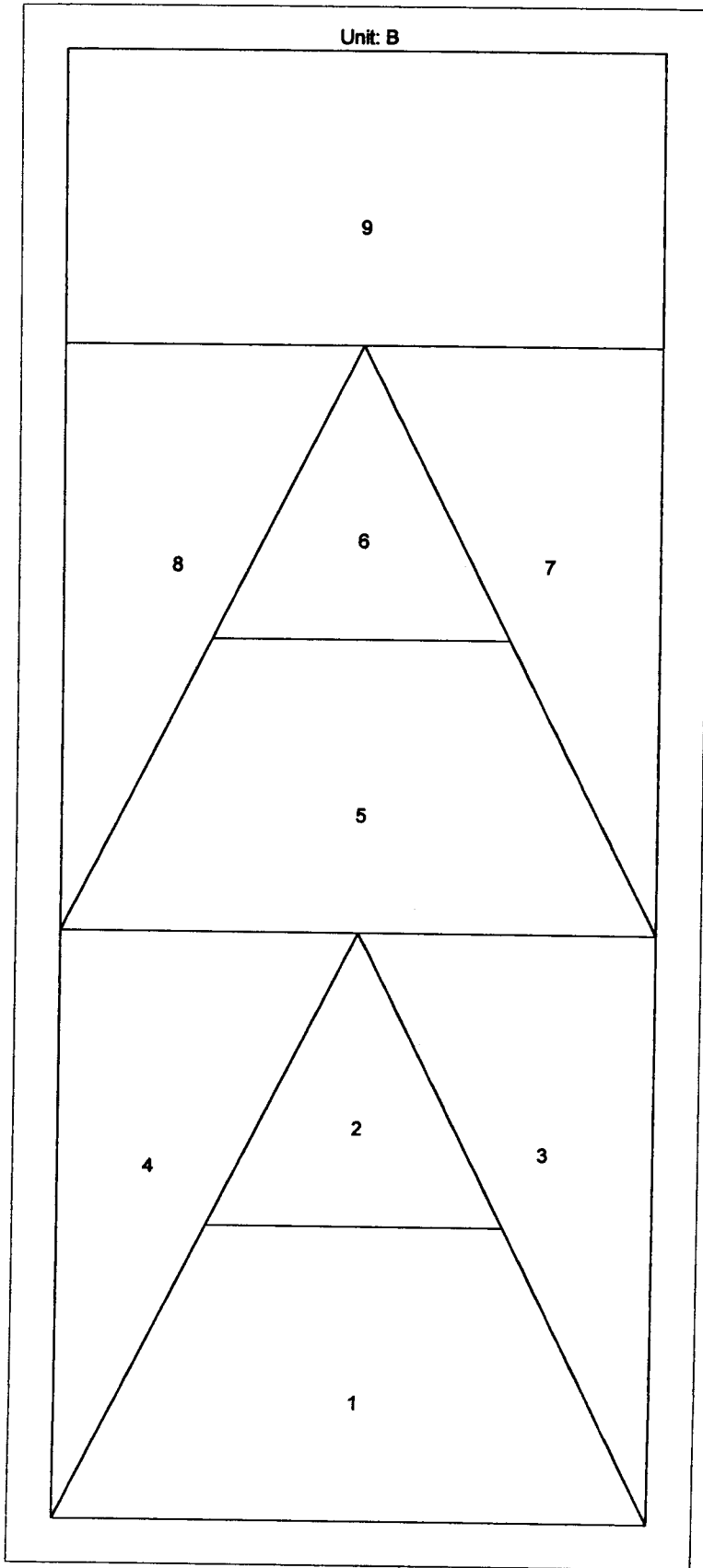
