

## Row 2: Tree Block - November Drawing

Please read all instructions before beginning. This block will be 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" unfinished (6" x 6 3/4" finished).

This is the second block in a series. Make blocks in the colors indicated for the block of the month drawing at the November meeting, and make seven blocks in the colors of your choice for your row quilt.

- ✓ Background – pale blue (this is the sky)
- ✓ Tree – your choice of green (can be one fabric or three – one for each section of the tree)
- ✓ Tree trunk - tan or brown

For the block of the month your fabrics should be a pleasing green with medium to small print and the general feel should be cheerful. You will want to consider the feeling you want your quilt to have when picking the fabrics for your row quilt. Don't feel that all your trees must be green. This is a great quilt to making using up your scraps from previous quilts.

Cutting for one block:

Background (D) cut 2 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles	Tree (A) cut 1 2" x 3 1/2" rectangle
Background (E) cut 2 2" x 2 3/4" rectangles	Tree (B) cut 1 2" x 5" rectangle
Background (F) cut 2 2" squares	Tree (C) cut 1 2" x 6 1/2" rectangle
Background (G) cut 2 2" x 3" rectangles	Tree trunk (H) cut 1 1 1/2" x 2" rectangle
Background (I) cut 1 1 1/4" x 6 3/4" rectangle	

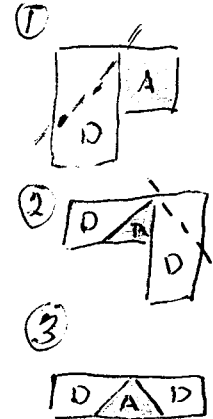
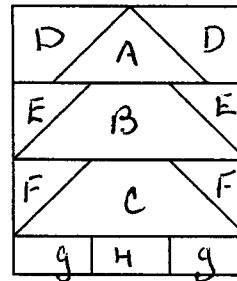
Sew a Background (D) diagonally to the each end Tree (A).  
Press to the corner and cut away the extra layers

Sew a Background (E) diagonally to the each end Tree (B).  
Press to the corner and cut away the extra layers

Sew a Background (F) diagonally to the each end Tree (C).  
Press to the corner and cut away the extra layers

Sew a Background (G) to each side of Tree trunk (H)

Sew rows together to form a tree, sew Background (I) across the top



Additional cutting for your row:

Sashing: eight 1 1/4" x 7 1/2" rectangles (same or similar to your background fabrics or a contrast for a scrappier look)

Assemble as follows:



You should have a row that is approximately 46 1/2" x 7 1/2". The actual length of your row should match Row 1 from last month (this may vary slightly as everyone does not sew the same exact 1/4" seam). Put this row in a safe place-until you are ready to assemble your quilt.
