

Block of the month Jan 2006 Glacier Bay

Use off white background fabric. Select a dark and a medium fabric.

From background cut two  $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half on the diagonal. Cut eight  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half on the diagonal.

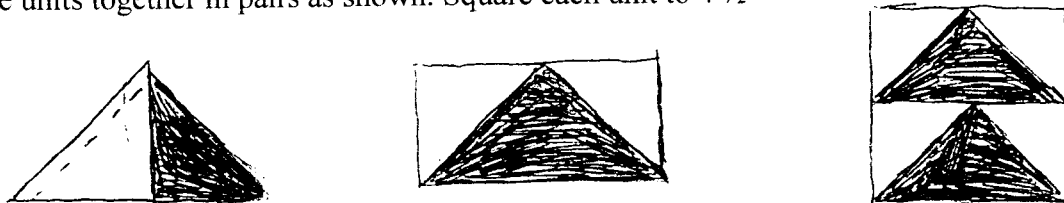
From the medium fabric cut one  $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " square for center. Cut two  $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half on the diagonal.

From the dark fabric cut two  $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut along both diagonals forming 8 triangles. Cut two  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half on the diagonal.

Make center unit: Sew one small dark triangle to each side of  $3 \frac{2}{8}$ " square. Square completed unit to  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Make side units: Sew one background triangle to each side of larger dark triangles. Sew these units together in pairs as shown. Square each unit to  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Make corner units: Sew medium triangles and background triangles together forming squares. Square each unit to  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ", Assemble block as shown.
