

Block of the month April 2006

Fabrics required:

One  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square large print or novelty fabric  
Light, medium and dark fabric to complement center

Cutting directions:

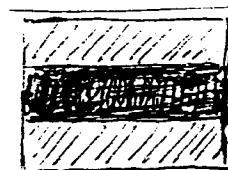
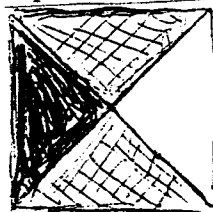
From light fabric cut one  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Cut on both diagonals to form 4 triangles.

From medium fabric cut two  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut these along both diagonals making 8 triangles. Also cut eight rectangles  $1\frac{7}{8}$  x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

From dark fabric cut one  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Cut along both diagonals to form 4 triangles. Cut 4 rectangles  $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Sewing directions:

Sew medium triangles to light and dark triangles along short sides as shown. Have medium triangles on top when sewing them together. Press toward medium. Sew pairs of triangles together to form squares as shown. Square units to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Sew rectangles together as shown with dark fabric in the middle. Press toward medium fabric. Square units to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". Assemble block as shown in diagram. You can reverse the light and dark fabrics.
