

Block of the Month June 2006

Select a white on white background and five complementary colors.

From background cut six $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half on the diagonal making 12 triangles for corner units. Cut one $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Cut along both diagonals making 4 triangles for side units.

Color #1 (center) Cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Color #2 (~~corner~~ units) Cut two $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half on the diagonal making 4 triangles.

Color #3 (side units) Cut two $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut in half on the diagonal making 4 triangles.

Color #4 (side units) Cut one $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Cut in half on both diagonals making 4 triangles.

Color #5 (corner units) Cut two $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut along diagonals making 4 triangles

Make 4 corner units:

Sew small background triangles to color #5 triangles making four half square triangles (fig. A) Sew small background triangles to adjacent sides of each square as shown in fig B
Sew color #2 triangles to each of these units as shown in figure C.

Make 4 side units:

Sew background triangles to short sides of color #4 triangles as shown in fig. D. be sure dark triangles are on the right side as in illustration.

Sew color #3 triangles to each of these units as in fig. E

Assemble block following diagram.
