

Block of the month January 2007

Select a medium or dark blue for background and a white on white for the contrast fabric.

From the background cut:

One  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square cut in fourths on the diagonal making 4 large triangles

Two  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares cut in half on the diagonal making 4 medium triangles

$2\frac{3}{8}$ "

Six  ~~$2\frac{5}{8}$ "~~ squares cut on half on the diagonal making 12 small triangles

Four  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From white fabric cut eighteen  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " squares. Cut these in half on the diagonal making 36 small triangles

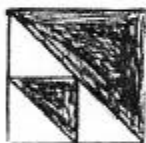
Sew 12 pairs of blue and white small triangles together making 12 half square triangles. Press toward dark.



Sew one small white triangle on each side of the half squares as shown. You will have 12 of these units.



Sew one of these units to the long side of each of the medium triangles as shown :



Sew one of the triangle units to each short side of the large triangles as shown. Make four of these side units.



Assemble block as shown in diagram:
