

Block of the month Feb 2007

Select a white on white background fabric and 5 different red fabrics

Cutting directions:

From background cut one $3\frac{3}{4}$ " square

Two $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

Two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Two strips $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 10 "

Two strips $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

From color #1 (main color) cut Two rectangles $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x $6\frac{3}{4}$ "

Three $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

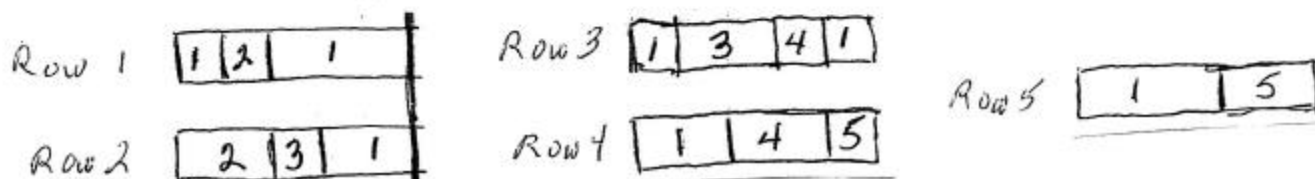
Two rectangles $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

Two rectangles $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3 "

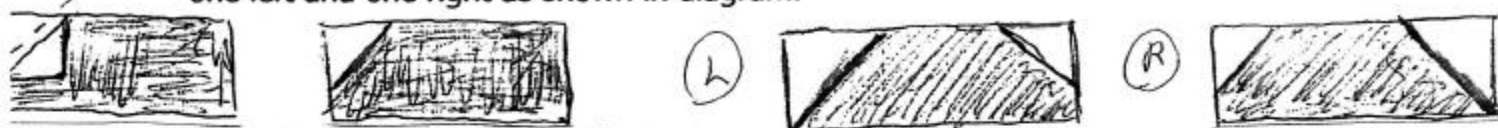
From each of colors # 2,3,4, and 5 Cut one $1\frac{3}{4}$ " square

One rectangle $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3 "

Lay out center unit as shown in diagram. Sew one row at a time. Press seams of the rows in opposite directions.

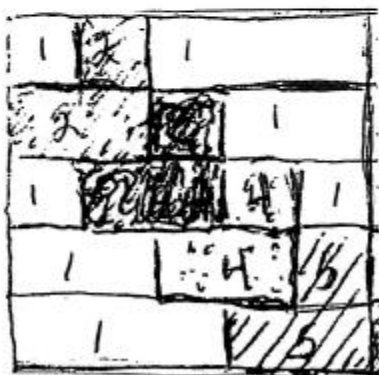


Make side units: Sew one $1\frac{3}{4}$ " square to one corner on the diagonal. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press toward corner. Repeat using $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square on opposite corner. Make one left and one right as shown in diagram.



Assemble block as shown in illustration.
