

Block of the month April 2007 "scrappy snail"

Select five different medium to dark batik fabrics and five different off white background fabrics.

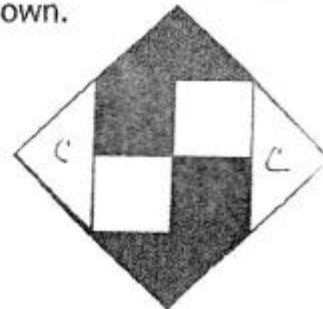
Using a different fabric for each piece, cut the following from the colored fabrics:

- A. One $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " square cut along both diagonals
- B. One $6 \frac{7}{8}$ " square cut in half on the diagonal
- C. One $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " square cut along both diagonals
- D. One $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " square cut in half on the diagonal
- E. Two 2" squares

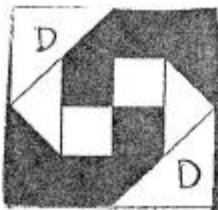
Cut identical pieces from background fabrics.

Sew a four patch with the 2" squares.

Start block with 4-patch in the center. Be sure a dark square is in the upper left corner. Sew "C" triangles to the center 4 patch as shown.



Sew "D" triangles onto square as shown.



Complete block sewing on "A" triangles, finishing with "B"triangles.
