

Block of the month August 2006

Fabrics required:

White on white background- 5 1/2" x 16" strip

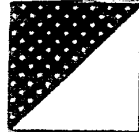
5 1/2" x 12" strips of four different fabrics in complimentary colors

From background fabric cut one 5 1/4" square. Cut along both diagonals making four triangles. Cut two 4 7/8" squares. Cut these along one diagonal making triangles.

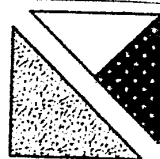
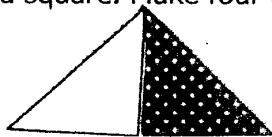
From each of the colored fabrics cut one 5 1/4" square. Cut in half along both diagonals making four triangles. Cut one 4 7/8" square. Cut in half along one diagonal making two triangles. You will have two extra triangles in each color.

For best results lay out pieces as shown in diagram.

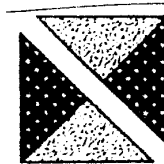
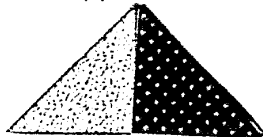
Make corner units. Sew one large background triangle to one large colored triangle. Make four of these units using a different color for each one.



Make side units. Sew one small background triangle to one small colored triangle along one short side as shown making larger triangle. Sew this triangle to a large colored triangle making a square. Make four of these units.



Make center unit. Sew small colored triangles together in pairs along one short side. Press seams of each in opposite directions. Sew together along the long side making center square.



Assemble entire block as shown in diagram.
