

Block of the Month September 2006

Select an off white background and Three complementary fabrics in fall colors- light, medium and dark.

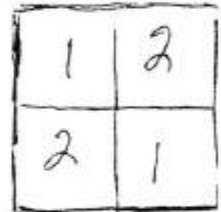
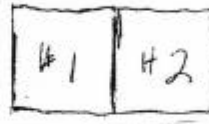
From background fabric cut sixteen 2 1/2" squares

Color #1(light) cut two 4 1/2" squares and two 2 1/2" squares

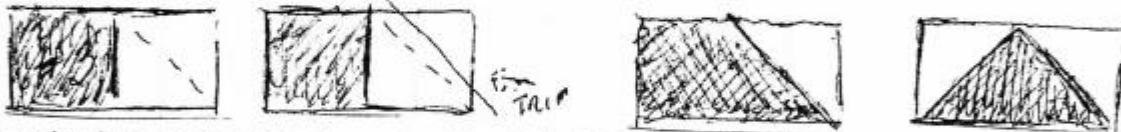
Color #2(medium) cut two 4 1/2" squares and two 2 1/2" squares

Color #3(dark) cut four rectangles 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Make four patch for center. With right sides together sew a medium square to a light square. Repeat . Press toward medium fabric. Sew both halves together.



Make four "flying geese" units. Draw a line on the diagonals of eight of the background squares. With right sides together sew a background square to one side of the dark rectangles on the drawn line as shown. Trim seam allowance 1/4" from drawn line as shown. Press toward the corner. Repeat for other side. Make four of these units.



Sew a background square to each side of the "flying geese" units.

Sew a flying geese unit to each side of the center four patch.



Sew one light and one medium square to each of the remaining flying geese. Assemble as shown in diagram.
