

Instructions for 2011 Quilt Show entries

How to submit your entry: Complete a separate entry form for each item you wish to enter in the show. Entries may be sent as an e-mail attachment to lmorton23@msn.com or by US mail to Linda Morton, 7447 Roundup Ln NW, Silverdale, WA 98383. There is a copy of the registration on the website. A receipt and a copy of the registration form with your entry number will be available at the October guild meeting. If you aren't at the meeting, it will be mailed to you. You must be a current member of the West Sound Quilters to enter the show. Please indicate a hanging preference for each entry. If there are too many quilts to hang, some will be excluded according to your hanging preference. The hanging chair needs to know what size your entry is, so please measure your entry.

Judging: Quilts will not be judged this year. A few ribbons will be awarded for Viewer's choice, etc, but individual categories will not be judged.

Challenge: The challenge category for this year is "Civil War". All challenge quilts **MUST** be registered.

For Sale: If your quilt is for sale, please mark the space provided, and provide us with a **PRICE**. It would be helpful if you could have a list of items for sale at the show. If someone is interested in buying your quilt, they can leave their phone number at the lobby, and you can contact them directly.

Kits: If a purchased, pre-packaged kit was used to make this quilt, please tell us.

Pattern and/or book used: Please indicate which pattern or book was used to make your quilt. You are not only giving credit to the designer, but many people may want to make a similar quilt, and want to know which pattern was used.

Sleeves: Sleeves are required on all quilts except Miniatures. An instruction sheet for making sleeves will be included with your registration form and receipt.

Comments: Please fill out the comments section, people love to hear about your work. Tell what inspired you to make the entry, technique or method. Tell about special techniques used (embellishments, etc). Who was the quilt made for? Space is limited, so if your comments are extensive, please print them on a separate sheet of paper to be hung with your entry.

Categories: Hopefully the categories are self-explanatory. Please choose only **ONE** category for your entry, even though it may qualify for several. If your quilt was made or started in a workshop, it should be entered in the **Workshop** category. **Applique** quilts should be at least 60% hand or machine appliqued. Machine piecing is OK as long as 60% of the impact of the quilt is appliqued. As the **Machine Pieced** category is by far the largest, it would be better to place your entry in another category if possible.

Quilting: Please indicate how your quilt was quilted, and by whom. Please give credit to any professional or friend that may have quilted your quilt.

Deadline: All entry forms must be postmarked by September 25th 2011. Anything received later than that will not be accepted.

Drop-off Instructions: When you receive the paperwork, your items may be dropped off with any of the quilt receivers. Please make arrangements with them for a time for drop-off and pick-up. They will sign your receipt and return it to you. Your copy of the registration with your entry number needs to be pinned to the BACK left corner of your quilt. This will serve as identification. There will be a list of drop-off people in the newsletter, or you can contact Sharon Demianiw for a list. You will also be picking up your entry at the same place.

Withdrawals: If you have to withdraw an entry for any reason, inform Linda Morton 360-698-3088 as soon as possible. She must notify several other people immediately (the hanging chair, the program person, etc)
